

The Clinical Establishments (Registration & Regulation) Act, 2010.

Introduction: The Clinical Establishments (Registration & Regulation) Act, 2010 has been enacted by the Central Government to provide for registration and regulation of all clinical establishments in the country with a view to prescribe the minimum standards of facilities and services provided by them.

Goals:

- a). To provide minimum acceptable quality of services to the community.
- b). To create awareness among the community regarding registered medical practitioners and establishments so as to phase out quacks from the country.
