

**TENDER NOTICE**

Sealed Tenders are hereby invited on behalf of the Chairman, Mizoram State Health Society from reputed and bonafide Manufacturers or Authorized Distributors, Stockists or Agents who have GST registration for '**Open Tender for Supply of Medicines under NHM, Mizoram**' which will be received by the Mission Director, NHM, Health & FW Department, Dinthar, Aizawl, Mizoram, on or before **20<sup>th</sup> March 2026 (Friday), upto 12:00 Noon** under the terms and conditions laid down below. Quotations are to be opened by Mission Director, NHM, Mizoram, Aizawl or his authorized representatives at **1:00 PM** on the same day. The Tenderers or their representatives may also be present at the time of opening of the Tender, if desired.

**TERMS & CONDITIONS**

1. Authorized Distributors/Stockist or agents should furnish Photo copy of their Distributorship or Stockist or Agencies Certificate duly attested by a Gazetted Officer or Notary and should produce Original Certificate at the time of opening the tender, if demanded.
2. All pages of the tender should be duly numbered and page index maintained at the first page of the tender document.
3. Quotation of rates with name of manufacturer and brandname etc. should be submitted in the prescribed form only which can be obtained from the office of Mission Director, National Health Mission, Mizoram, Aizawl on working days.
4. The cover of the tenders should be superscribed as '**Open Tender for Supply of Medicines & Consumables under NHM, Mizoram**' addressed to the Mission Director, National Health Mission, Mizoram, Aizawl and should clearly indicate full postal address of the tenderer.
5. Non-tribal tenderer should affix a Non- Judicial Court Fee Stamp worth at least Rs.7.50/- and should furnish attested copy of GST registration certificate by the concerned authority.
6. The tribal tenderer should furnish attested copy of Tribal Certificate and GST Registration issued by the competent authority. Original copies should be produced at the time of opening, if demanded.
7. Tenders should be accompanied with the Earnest Money Deposit of 2% of the total value of the quoted items in the form of Demand Draft/Deposit at Call in original, from any Nationalized Bank of India or Postal Saving Certificate duly pledged in favor of Mission Director, National Health Mission, Mizoram, Aizawl.
8. Manufacturers submitting their tenders directly should attach photostat copies of their Manufacturing Licence, Drugs Licence, CIN (Corporate Identity Number) and other relevant permissions/licences required for such manufacturing, duly attested by a Gazetted Officer or Notary. Original Certificates should be produced at the time of opening of the tenders/quotations, if demanded.

9. The Supplier must complete the delivery of the ordered items strictly within the delivery period stipulated by the State Health Society. In case of failure to supply within the specified time:
  - i) A penalty may be imposed as deemed appropriate by the Society
  - ii) The Society reserves the right to cancel the supply order in part or in full, if supply cannot be made without any intimation. The society shall also have the right to procure the items from alternative sources from the fund sanctioned against such items and the said purchase would not entail any legal implication on the part of the Society.
10. At the time of supply, items etc. should have at least one year shelf-life before its expiry date from manufacture and expiry date must be indicated on the body of the items supplied by the suppliers. Besides, the supplier shall mandatorily submit a Certificate of Analysis (CoA) for each batch of Medicines supplied. The CoA must be issued either by Govt. Approves Testing Laboratory or the In-House Quality Control Laboratory of the manufacturer.
11. No price escalation will be permissible and rates of items over and above approved rates will not be accepted and quoted rates shall not exceed the printed MRP of the quoted items.
12. All tenders/quotations shall be accompanied by attested copy of valid General Drugs Licence.
13. The tenderer should submit attested/notarized copy of upto date ISO/GMP Certificate alongwith tender documents.
14. Tenderer should quote their rates in terms of *Indian Rupees*. Rates should be quoted inclusive of all taxes and duties which should be mentioned clearly in the quotation.
15. Tenderer should mention F.O.R Destination - Central Medical Store, Zembawk and rates thereof.
16. Tenderer must furnish detail specification of the items quoted. Tenderer should submit samples against each quoted item in the case of medicines. The samples submitted against each item mentioned in the prescribed form should be labelled with the name of the firm and the serial number as per the prescribed format.
17. The supplied items should conform to the quality standards as prescribed for each item. In case of any item found to be 'not of standard quality', the firm shall be considered for blacklisting and the supplier shall retrieve all batches of the product as it shall be deemed to be rejected goods. The Society will be at the liberty to arrange alternative procurement from any other source.
18. Soft copy of tender documents shall be enclosed alongwith other documents.
19. All pages of the tender papers should be printed, signed, stamped and dated; hand written quotations shall not be entertained. Any page or pages not signed, stamped and dated will be marked violated clause at the time of opening of tender.
20. If any tenderer violates or fails to fulfill any one of the clauses, his or her tender are liable to be rejected at the time of opening the tender by the *Technical Committee and Purchase Board, MSHS*.
21. A successful firm should furnish Security Deposit of 5% of the value of the supply before issue of supply order in the form of Demand Draft/Fixed Deposit in any Nationalized Bank of India or Postal Saving Certificate, as the case may be, duly pledged in favor of Mission Director, National Health Mission, Mizoram, Aizawl.
22. A successful firm should execute an appropriate *Deed of Agreement* within 15 days from the date of issue of acceptance of their quoted rates failing which the firm will be treated as invalid tenderer.

23. The undersigned shall not be bound to accept the lowest rate.
24. Late/delayed tenders will not be entertained. Certificates other than those stated in the above clauses should not be attached. Any other/further clarifications in connection with submission of the tender may be made from the office of Mission Director, National Health Mission, Mizoram, Aizawl during office hours on all working days.
25. In case of any legal disputes/litigations arising out of this Tender Notice or its terms, the Courts of Law at Aizawl only shall have jurisdiction to adjudicate the same.
26. All payments will be made only after the items are received in full and in good condition duly approved/accepted by the *Vigilance Committee*, H & FW Dept. Part payment will not be entertained.
27. Any attempts for negotiation/campaign, direct or indirect, on the part of a tenderer with the authority to whom he has submitted the Tender or the authority who is competent finally to accept, shall render such Tender liable to be excluded from consideration, if proved.
